Worksheet (Grammar)**Present Continuous****Usage:**

First, we use the present continuous for things that are happening at the moment of speaking. These things usually last for quite a short time and they are not finished when we are talking about them.

Examples: I'm working at the moment.

Please call back as we are eating dinner now.

Be careful! Julie is sleeping.

2: We can also use this tense for other kinds of temporary situations, even if the action isn't happening at this moment.

Examples: John's working in a bar until he finds a job in his field.

I'm reading a really great book.

She's staying with her friend for a week.

3: We can use the present continuous for temporary or new habits (for normal habits that continue for a long time, we use the present simple). We often use this with expressions like 'these days' or 'at the moment'.

Examples: He's eating a lot these days.

She's swimming every morning (she didn't use to do this).

You're smoking too much.

Listen!, Look!, be careful!

Form:

☺ Affirmative Form: Subject + V. To Be (is/are/am)+ Verb-ing + complement

Examples: I am eating lunch now.

She is reading a book at the moment.

Look! They are playing football.

☺ Negative Form: Subject + am/is/are + not + verb-ing

Examples: I am not eating lunch now.

She is not reading a book at the moment.

Look! They are not playing football.

☺ Question Form:

A. Yes or No question: Am/Is/Are + subject + verb-ing?

Examples: Am I eating lunch now?

Is she reading a book?

Are they playing football?

B. Wh question: Wh-word + am/is/are + subject + verb(-ing) + object?

Examples: What are you doing? → I'm reading a book.

Where is she going? → She is going to the park.

Why are they running? → They are late for school.

☺☺ Spelling:

RULE	EXAMPLES
Most verbs add ing :	hold – holding read – reading drink – drinking
Verbs ending in e , erase the e and add ing	take – taking leave – leaving
Verbs ending in x , y , w , just add ing	enjoy - enjoying study - studying
Verbs that end in consonant vowel consonant and the last syllable is stressed: double the last consonant and add ing	swim – swimming run – running put – putting Non-stressed syllable: happen - happening
Verbs that end in ie , change the ie to y before adding ing :	die – dying lie – lying
