



Embedded Questions - Summary & Worksheet

Summary:

Embedded Questions are polite indirect questions.

We use phrases like:

- Can you tell me
- Do you know
- I wonder
- Could you tell me

If the direct question is Yes/No, use 'if' or 'whether'.

Don't change the word order after the question word (what, where, when, etc).

Examples:

What should we do?

-> Can you tell me what we should do?

Is it a new medicine?

-> Do you know if it is a new medicine?

Who invented Penicillin?

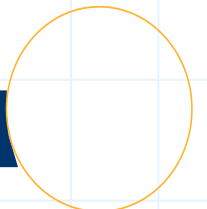
-> Could you tell me who invented Penicillin?
