What is AI? AI is already a part of our lives in the form of the computer technology. This type of AI is called Narrow AI and it focuses on a particular task it has been programmed to do. For example, it can be used for the GPS systems in a car, or the voice recognition systems that let us talk to our smart devices. AI suggests things for us to listen to, it can remind us to do something important, and is also used in social media to send users adverts. General AI, on the other hand, allows machines to learn, reason and make judgements based on previous experiences – just like humans! This kind of super-intelligence isn't a reality quite yet, but the aim is to teach it to do better than humans in all tasks that require mental effort. There are disagreements about when General AI might become a reality. Some experts say never, while others believe it could happen as early as 2045.
