**Worksheet (1)****The present simple****The present simple**

Function: We use the present simple to talk about:



1-Facts and general truths (Water boils at 100 Celsius)

2-Routines and habits (We usually go to the park)

\*Common time expressions used with present simple ( always/every+time/never usually/often/sometimes/hardly ever/daily/monthly/occasionally/rarely/seldom)

\*The Form of the present simple:

Subject+V.1(s,es,ies)+obj.....

\*Note: -If the subject is **singular** (She/He/It/ Sarah) you must add (-s,-es,-ies) to the verb.

1-We add **-ies** to the verb if it ends with y preceded by a consonant.

ex: Study → studies Tidy → tidies

2-We add **-es** to the verb if it ends with(ch,sh,x,o,ss,z).

ex: Watch → watches Fix → fixes pass → passes

3-The other verbs that do not end with -y preceded by a consonant, or with -ch,-sh,-x,-o,-ss,-z , we simply add **-s**.

ex: play → plays visit → visits eat → eats

-If the subject is **plural** (They,We,You,I,more than one person) ,the verb stays in its base form without any addition.

ex: They play football everyday.

The negative form of the present simple:

Sub+don't/doesn't+V.1 + Obj.....

We use don't with plural pronouns.(They,We,You,I)

We use doesn't with singular pronouns.(She,He,It)

Note: With negative form we must use the base verb(infinitive verb)

ex: -She **doesn't** travel to London every year.

-They **don't** speak Italian daily.

The question form:

Do/Does +subject+V.1+com.....?

\*If a question begins with Do/Does, the answer is Yes or No. This is called a short answer.

ex: Do you like apples?

Yes,I do /No,I don't

Does he play football?


Yes,he does /No,he doesn't


\*If a question begins with Wh-questions(What,Where,When,Who,Why,How....), the answer must be a full sentence, not just Yes or No.

ex: Where do you live? I live in Amman.

\*Note: We put adverbs of frequency.

- Before the main verb
- After the verb be





ex: \*Do you **see** what I mean? (understand) state verb

I'm **seeing** my best friend tonight. (meet) Action verb

\*She **has** a new dress. (Own)

I'm **having** a shower. (take)
